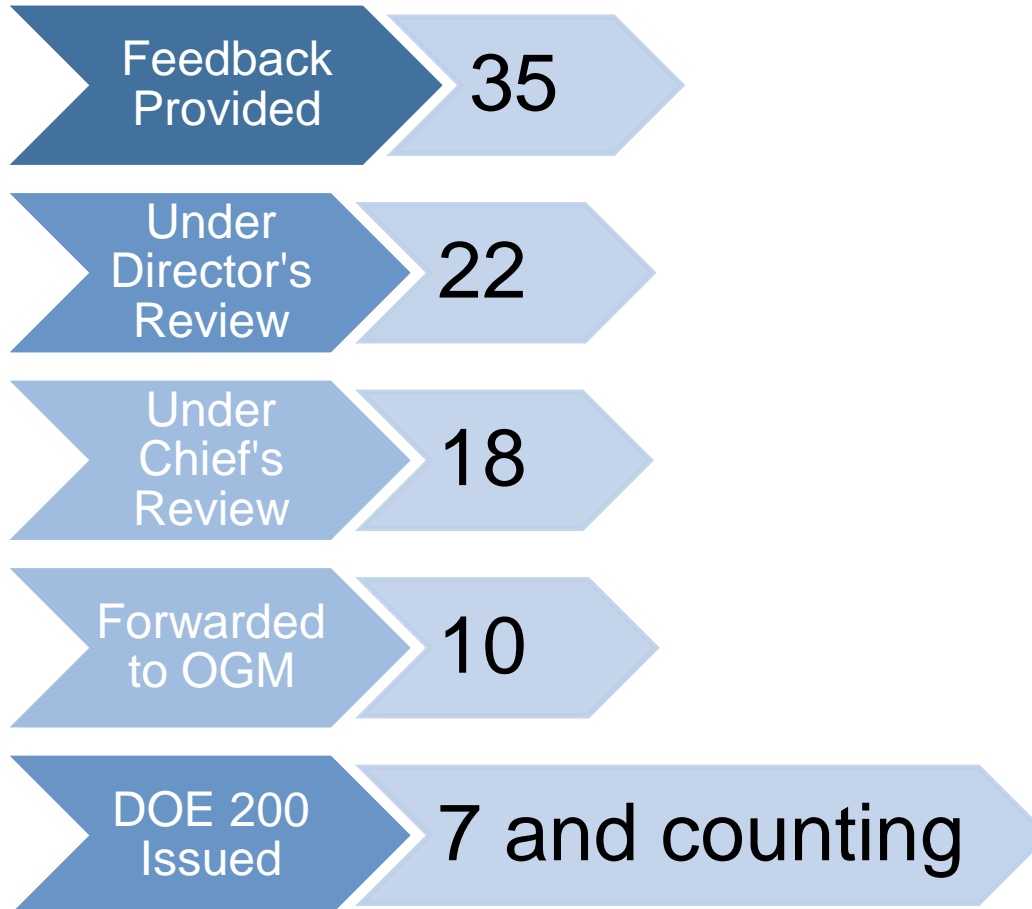

# Common Monitoring Findings

## Common Findings

- **Needs Assessment**- There were 20 LEAs that were out of compliance under criteria AIA-1 and AIA-2.
- **Highly Qualified Staff**- There were 12 LEAs that were out of compliance under criterion LIA-1.
- **Use of Funds**- There were 11 LEAs that were out of compliance under criteria IIA-1, 2, 3, and 4.
- **Parent and Family Engagement** - There were 10 LEAs that were out of compliance under criterion KIA-1.

# Community Eligibility Provision Timelines

Date	Requirement
April 1	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>To participate in CEP, individual schools, groups of schools, or entire LEAs must have an identified student percentage of at least 40 percent as of the most recent April 1</li> </ul>
April 15	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Florida Department of Agriculture notify LEAs of district-wide eligibility status and provide guidance and information</li> <li>LEAs submit school-level eligibility information to Florida Department of Agriculture.</li> </ul>
May 1	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Florida Department of Agriculture post the LEA district-wide and school-level lists on their website</li> </ul>
June 30	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Interested and eligible LEAs notify the Florida Department of Agriculture of their intent to participate in CEP</li> <li>LEAs planning to participate in CEP the following school year submit to the Florida Department of Agriculture identified student and total enrollment data that reflects April 1 data</li> </ul>
February	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Survey 3 Reporting of the prior year's data</li> </ul>

# Community Eligibility Provision Options for Ranking

- **Combination district**
  - **Meal applications and Direct Direct Certification with multiplier**
- **District-wide CEP participation**
  - **All schools participate in CEP with Multiplier**
  - **All schools participate in CEP no Multiplier**
