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# Can you provide a status update on HB 7069?

# Where do we stand with the administrative cap?

- What happens to districts that will not have rollover funds for the FY18-19 to supplement the 8 percent cap?
  - The 8% cap is applicable to district-level expenditures and includes both direct and indirect costs.

# Where do we stand with the administrative cap? (cont.)

- During the districts annual planning process for, FY18-19, consider:
  - Positions that can be funded at the school level
  - How programs and services can be implemented and funded at the school level
    - (Revise Schoolwide Plans and/or School Improvement Plans appropriately)

Has there been any progress on updating the school improvement template to meet ESSA Schoolwide Plan requirements?

- How should districts move forward with current SIP/SWP template?
  - D and F schools are required to complete a SIP.
  - Non-D/F Schools are not required to complete a SIP but may opt to do so yet ALL Title I-funded schools must have a SWP

Has there been any progress on updating the school improvement template to meet ESSA Schoolwide Plan requirements?

- BFEP and BSI created a rubric that schools and districts can use to evaluate whether the SIP meets ESSA SWP requirements
- BFEP created a SWP Checklist that outlines SWP requirements

# What is the status of FY16/17 Monitoring?

- Monitoring reports have been reviewed, approved, and sent to districts

# What are the expected changes to the monitoring process, timeline and workpapers?

- Evaluation Process
- Written Rank and Serve Process
- Comprehensive Needs Assessments
- Use of Set Asides



# Update on timeline for approval of Florida's ESSA Plan

- No updates to the timeline at this time

# Comparability: How are districts held accountable for meeting compliance with comparability?

- The department implements escalating consequences that include:
  - Additional monitoring
  - Implementation of a Corrective Action Plan
  - Conditions on Title I, Part A award
  - Reduction in funds

# Will districts still be able to request a waiver of the 15% roll forward provisions?

- Yes, there has been no change regarding this flexibility.
- Districts may still request a waiver of the 15% roll forward limit once every three years

# IS Title V funding being eliminated?

- The Rural Low Income School Program (Title V) is expected to be funded for FY18-19
- The project performance period changes to begin July 1, 2018

- The Department is actively in the development phase of the Enterprise Grants Management Application System (EGMA)
- Alignment to needs identified in a school level Comprehensive Needs Assessment

# General Updates-Title I, Part A (cont.)

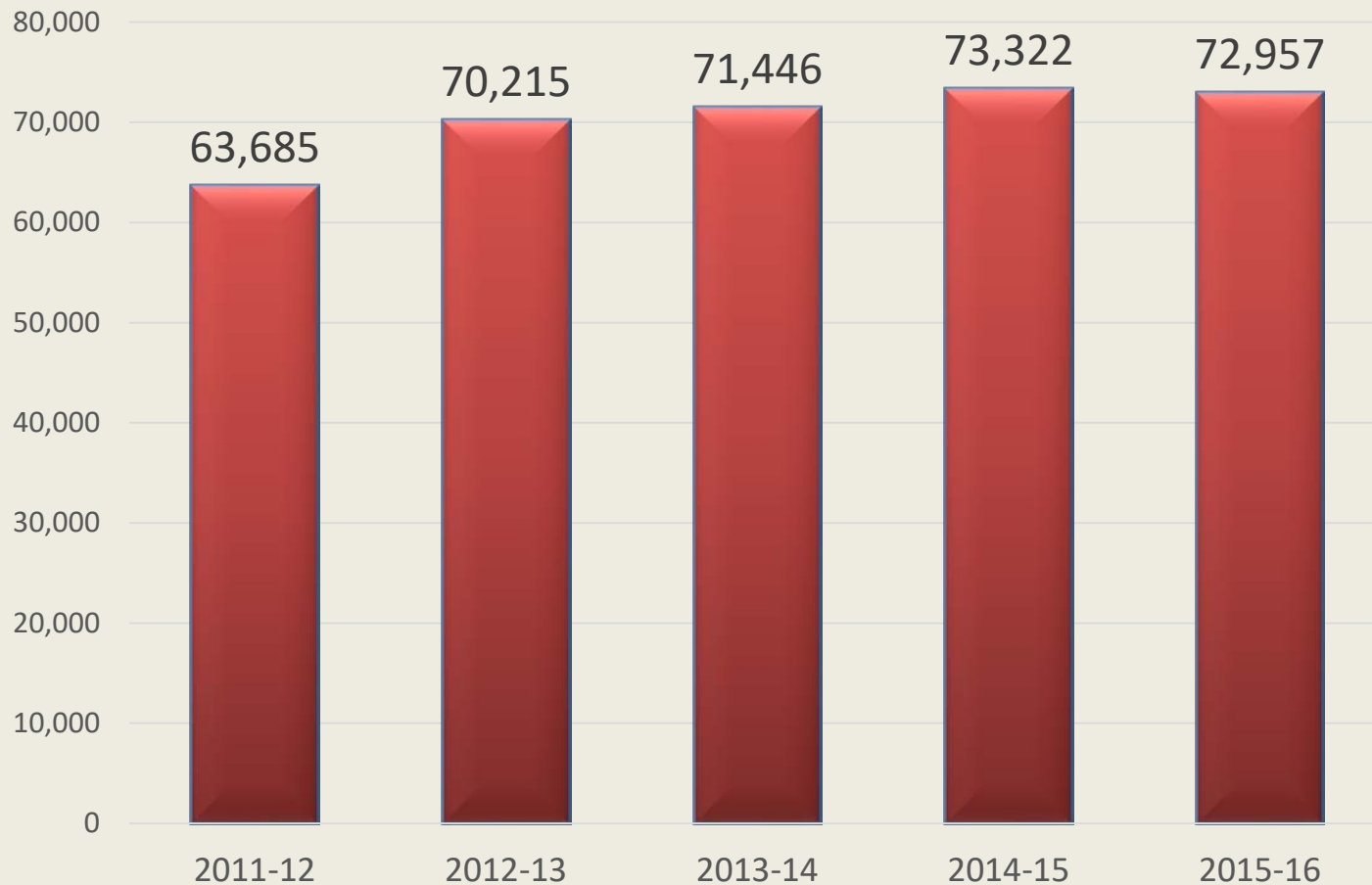
- Technical Assistance Papers are being revised and will become available as they are approved

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## General Updates-Title IX, Part A (Homeless Education Program)

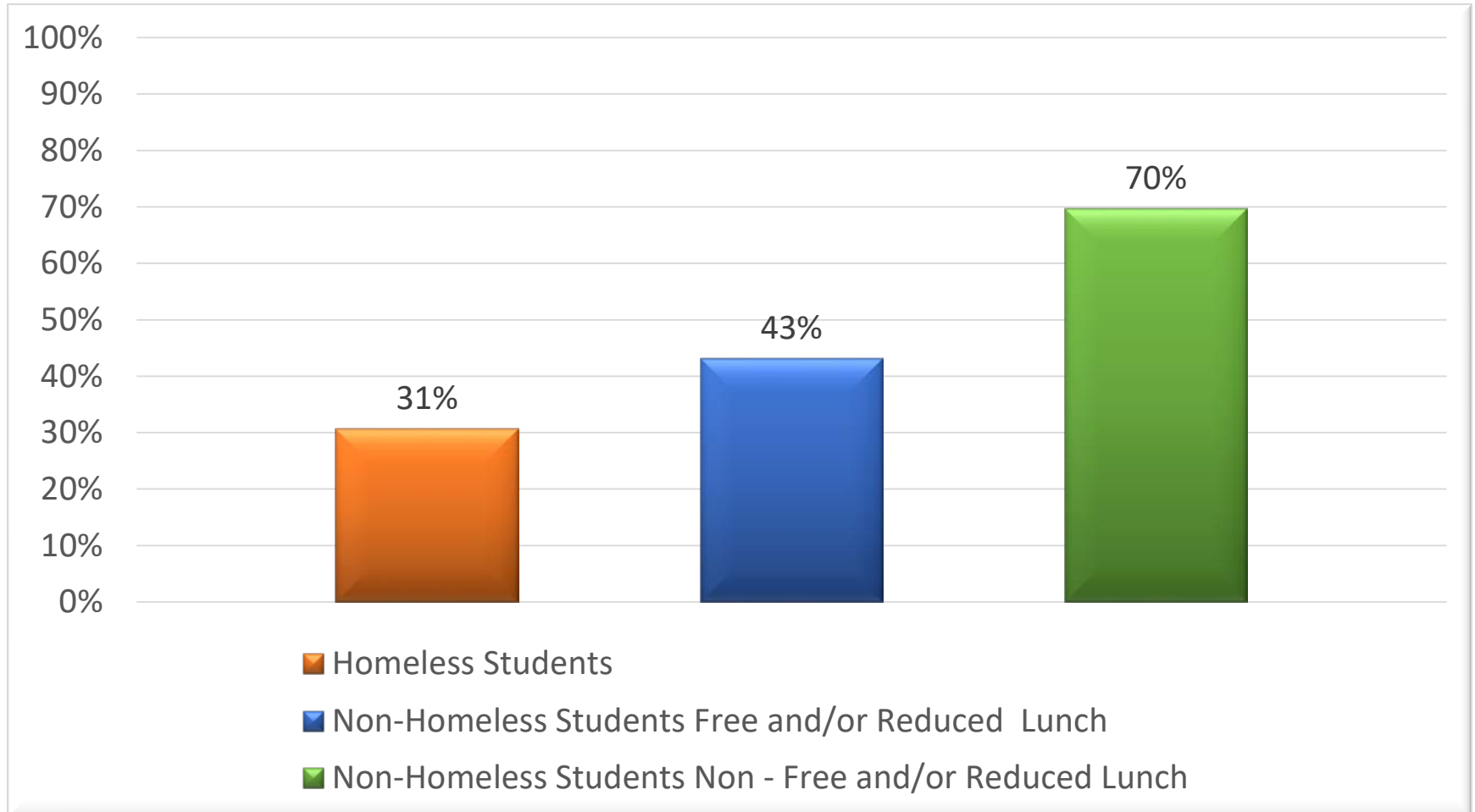
# Number of Identified Homeless Children and Youth





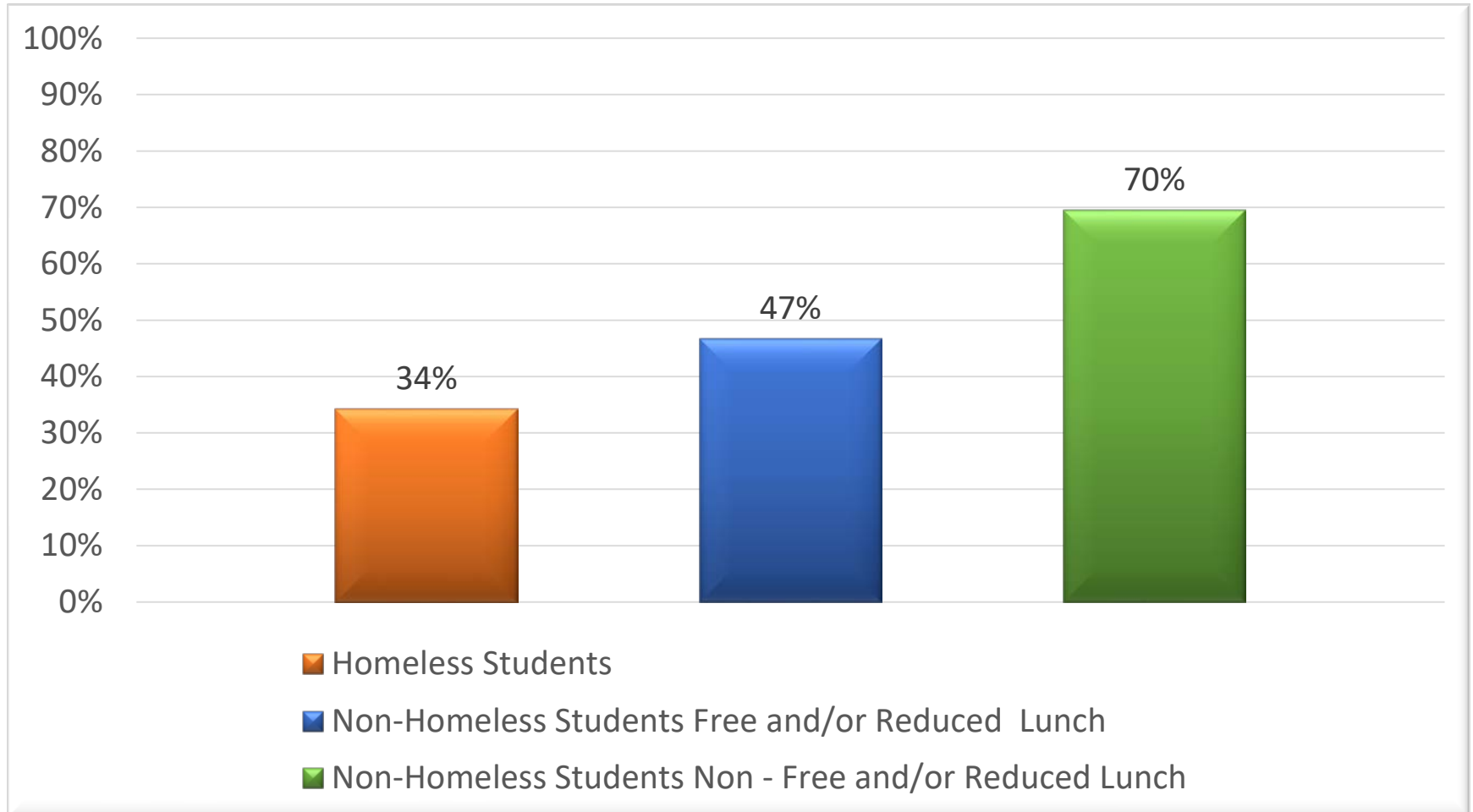
# English Language Arts

## Percent of Students Scoring at Level 3 or Higher



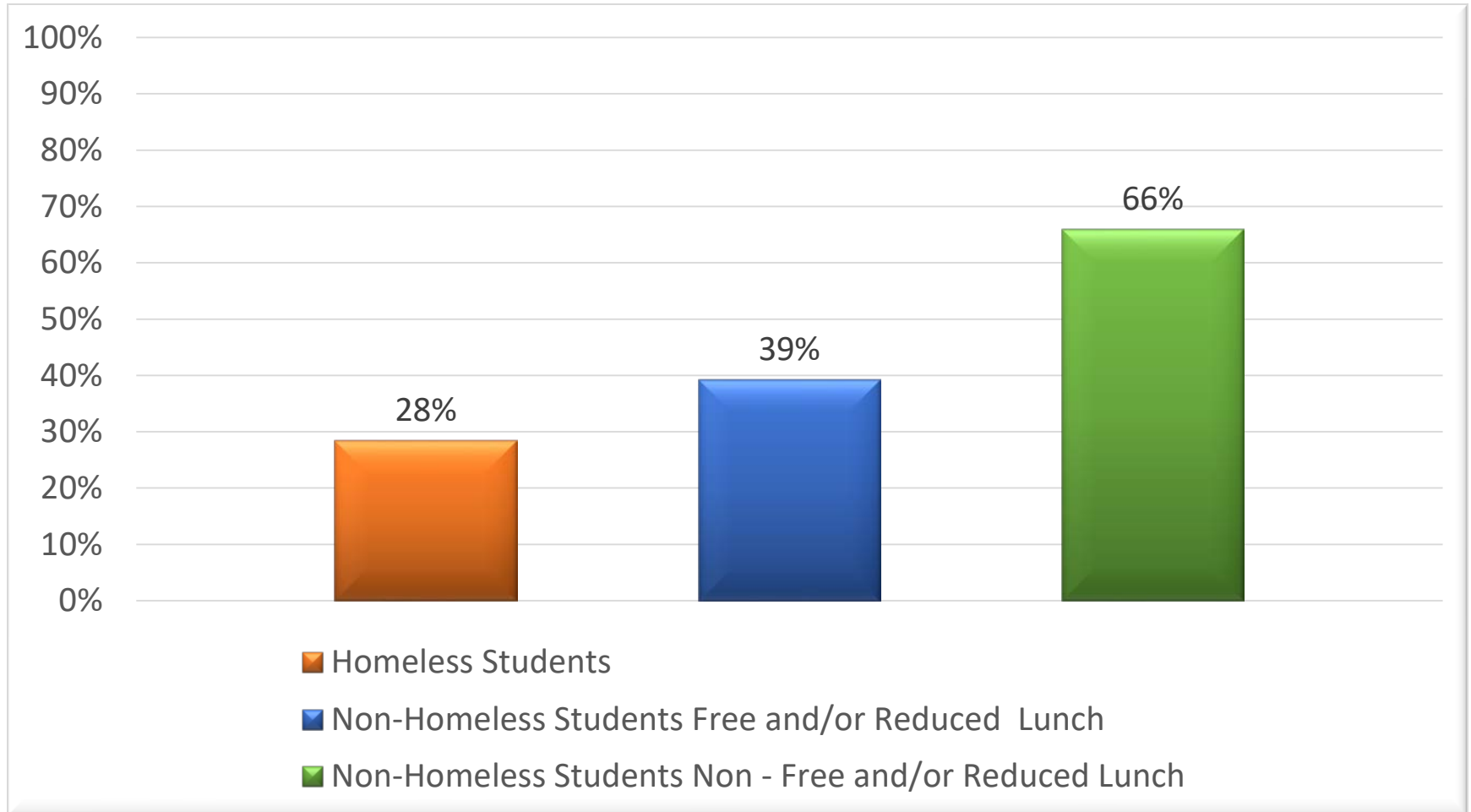
# Mathematics
