Federal education Laws (Elementary and Secondary Education Act, Sec. 1120(b) reauthorized as the Every Student Succeeds Act, Sec. 1117 (b) and Sec. 200.63 of the Title I regulations) require that timely and meaningful consultation occur between the local education agency (LEA) and private school officials prior to any decision that affects the opportunities of eligible private school children teachers, and other educational personnel to participate in programs under this act. 4. How, where and by whom the LEA will provide services to eligible private school children, including a thorough consideration and analysis of the views of the private school officials on the provision of services through a contract with a third party provider (not allowable)
5. How the LEA will assess academically the services to eligible private school children in accordance with Sec. 200.10 of the Title I regulations and how the LEA will use the results of that assessment to improve Title I instructional services;
6. The size and scope of the equitable services that the LEA will provide to eligible private school children and, consistent with §200.64, the proportion of funds that will be allocated to provide these services;
7. The method or sources of data that the LEA will use under §200.78 to determine the number of private school children from low income families residing in participating public school attendance areas, including whether the LEA will extrapolate data, if a survey is used;
8. The equitable services the LEA will provide to teachers and families of participating private school children; and
9. If the LEA disagrees with the private school officials' views on the provisions of services via a contract, the LEA must provide written reasons to the private school why the LEA chooses not to use a contractor.
